**ELECTION NOTIFICATION FOR INDIAN CRICKETERS' ASSOCIATION (ICA)  
ELECTION ON**

**27 OCTOBER 2022 TO 29 OCTOBER 2022**

**1. Election Notification**

Through this Notification (“**Election Notification**”), the Electoral Officer, BCCI (“**Electoral Officer**”) hereby announces the commencement of the Election Process for the General Election of the Indian Cricketers’ Association (“**ICA**”) to be held from 27 October to 29 October 2022 (“**ICA General Election 2022**”) for the posts specified hereinbelow and as further detailed in Paragraph 4 and Annexure I hereto (“**Posts**”).

Capitalised terms used herein but not defined, shall have the meanings ascribed to the terms under the Articles of Association of the ICA (“**ICA Articles**”):

- A. Five (5) Posts of Office Bearers under Article 8 of the ICA Articles; President, Secretary, Treasurer and Two (2) ICA Member Representatives;
  - B. Two (2) Post of ICA Representative Nominee to BCCI Apex Council under Article 12 of the ICA Articles;
  - C. One (1) Post of ICA Representative Nominee to IPL Governing Council under Article 12 of the ICA Articles; and
  - D. ICA Representative Nominees from the ICA Chapters specified herein to corresponding BCCI Member Associations under Article 13 of the ICA Articles (19 Male Member Representatives and 16 Female Member Representatives) as further detailed in Annexure I.
2. The ICA General Election 2022 process shall be conducted in accordance with the Schedule provided in *Table 1* below (“**Election Schedule**”).

### 3. Draft Electoral Roll

- (1) The Draft Electoral Roll for the ICA General Election 2022 consists of all Class-A Members as specified under Clause 6.1 of the ICA’s Election Guidelines dated September 29, 2022. For reference, Class-A Members are defined under Clause 1.2.21 (A) of the ICA Election Guidelines as follows:
- i) ICA Members who have paid the subscription fees as applicable to them for a particular Financial Year, before the due dates prescribed by the ICA Board of Directors from time to time for such fees; and
  - ii) ICA Members who have previously defaulted on payment of subscription fees and have completed a cooling-off period of one year (as prescribed for Class-C in the Election Guidelines) from the date of making payment of the outstanding dues.
- (2) It is hereby notified that the Draft Electoral Roll for the ICA General Election 2022 will be made available on <https://indiancricketersassociation.com/ica-general-elections-2022/> from 30 September 2022.
- (3) It is clarified that the Draft Electoral Roll is strictly tentative and may be subject to Revision based on Objections raised pursuant to which a Final Electoral Roll will be released on <https://indiancricketersassociation.com/ica-general-elections-2022/> in accordance with the Election Schedule. Only the Individuals enrolled in the Final Electoral Roll shall be permitted to participate in the ICA General Election 2022.
- (4) Any Objections regarding the composition or constitution of the Draft Electoral Roll may be sent via email marked with the subject line “**Sub: Objection – ICA General Election 2022 Draft Electoral Roll**” to [electoralofficer@indiancricketersassociation.com](mailto:electoralofficer@indiancricketersassociation.com) in accordance with the Election Schedule. The Electoral Officer shall Review such Objections and dispose them in accordance with the ICA Articles.

### 4. Posts, Eligibility Criteria and Voting Electorate

- (1) The Posts for which Elections shall be conducted during the ICA General Election 2022, the eligibility criteria and applicable voting electorate for each Post are specified below:

**A. ICA Board**

- (a) President
- (b) Secretary
- (c) Treasurer
- (d) Two (2) ICA Member Representative

*Article 8 (c) of the ICA Articles provides that at least one (1) Board member shall be woman. In order to facilitate this requirement, it is hereby clarified that in the event that a female candidate is not elected as a President, Secretary or Treasurer on the ICA Board, the female candidate who receives the highest number of votes for the Post of Member Representative (among female candidates only) shall be elected as a Member Representative, whether or not there is more than one (1) male candidate who receives higher votes than such female candidate.*

***Eligibility criteria:***

- (i) If Candidate is Male, played at least 5 International Test Matches and/or at least 25 First Class Matches; or*
- (ii) If Candidate is Female, played at least 10 First Class Matches; and*
- (iii) The Candidate must be enrolled on the Final Electoral Roll for the ICA General Election 2022.*

***Eligible Voting Electorate:***

All Members named in the Final Electoral Roll.

**B. ICA Representative Nominees to BCCI**

- (a) One (1) Male ICA Representative Nominee to BCCI Apex Council
- (b) One (1) Female ICA Representative Nominee to BCCI Apex Council
- (c) One (1) ICA Representative Nominee to IPL Governing Council

***Eligibility criteria:***

- (i) If Candidate is Male, played at least 5 International Test Matches and/or at least 25 First Class Matches;*
- (ii) If Candidate is Female, played at least 10 First Class Matches; and*
- (iii) The Candidate should not be “disqualified” to be a Councillor of the BCCI in the case of the BCCI Apex Council and a member of the IPL Governing Council in the case of the IPL Governing Council, under the BCCI Rules and Regulations, respectively; and*
- (iv) The Candidate must be enrolled on the Final Electoral Roll.*

***Eligible Voting Electorate:***

All Members named in the Final Electoral Roll.

**C. ICA Representative Nominees from ICA Chapters to Corresponding BCCI Member Associations' Apex Body**

The list of Posts for which Elections shall be conducted is specified in Annexure I enclosed.

***Eligibility criteria:*** *The Candidate must be Enrolled on the Final Electoral Roll from the ICA Chapter correlating to the BCCI Member Association's Apex Body in respect of which he/she wishes to stand for the election as Representative.*

*It is clarified that:*

- (i) Only ICA Chapters with at least Ten (10) male voters on the Final Electoral Roll shall elect male representative nominees to the Apex Body of their corresponding BCCI Member Association in the ICA General Election 2022; and*
- (ii) Only ICA Chapters with at least Five (5) female voters on the Final Electoral Roll shall elect female representative nominees to the Apex Body of their corresponding BCCI Member Association in the ICA General Election 2022; and*
- (iii) ICA Chapters that do not have at least Ten (10) male voters on the Final Electoral Roll and/or Five (5) female voters on the Final Electoral Roll, shall not have an election to elect their male and/or female representative nominees (as the case may be) to the Apex Body of the corresponding BCCI Member Association(s). In such case, the representative nominees to the Apex Body of the corresponding BCCI Member Association of such ICA Chapters shall be nominated by the duly elected ICA Board after the completion of the ICA General Election 2022.*

***Eligible Voting Electorate:***

All Members allocated to such ICA Chapter in the Final Electoral Roll.

- (2) The appointment and tenure of all individuals elected or nominated (as the case may be) for a Post in the BCCI or BCCI Member Association shall be subject to the BCCI Rules and Regulations and the constitutions of the relevant BCCI Member Association.

**5. Nominations**

- (1) The Electoral Officer hereby invites eligible Members who have been included in the Final Electoral Roll to submit Nomination Applications to contest for Posts for which Elections shall be held during the ICA General Election 2022 in accordance with the Election Schedule.

- (2) A Candidate wishing to contest for a Post for which Election is being conducted during the ICA General Election 2022 will be able to contest provided that such Candidate is eligible to contest for such Post in accordance with the criteria specified in para 4 above and is required to fill the Nomination-cum Affidavit Form ("**Nomination Form**") as prescribed below:
- a) **ICA Office Bearers Posts** - A Candidate who wants to contest for an ICA Office Bearer's Post should Fill the Nomination Form placed as Annexure II, Form A ("**Form A**"). The Form A should be Duly completed by the Candidate along with required Documents and with signature of the Candidate. The Candidature of the Candidate should be signed by a Proposer and a Secunder. The Proposer and a Secunder should be a Person who has been enrolled in the Final Electoral Roll published by the Electoral Officer. The Form A should be Duly Attested by a Notary/ Oath Commissioner.
  - b) **ICA Representative Nominee to BCCI Apex Council and IPL Governing Council Posts** - A Candidate who wants to contest for ICA Representative Nominee to BCCI Apex Council or IPL Governing Council Posts should Fill the Nomination Form placed as Annexure II, Form B ("**Form B**"). The Form B should be Duly completed by the Candidate along with required Documents and with signature of the Candidate. The Candidature of the Candidate should be signed by a Proposer and a Secunder. The Proposer and a Secunder should be a Person who has been enrolled in the Final Electoral Roll published by the Electoral Officer. The Form B should be Duly Attested by a Notary/ Oath Commissioner.
  - c) **ICA Representative to BCCI Member Associations' Posts** - A Candidate who wants to contest for ICA Representative to BCCI Members Associations' Posts should Fill the Nomination Form placed as Annexure II, Form C ("**Form C**"). The Form C should be Duly completed by the Candidate along with required Documents and with signature of the Candidate. The Candidature of the Candidate should be signed by a Proposer and a Secunder. The Proposer and a Secunder should be a Person who has been enrolled in the Final Electoral Roll published by the Electoral Officer and belong to the corresponding ICA Chapter of the concerned BCCI Member Association's Apex Body to which the candidate is seeking to file his/her candidature. The Form C should be Duly Attested by a Notary/ Oath Commissioner.
- (3) A Candidate must fill up the prescribed Nomination Form as applicable to the Post that the Candidate wishes to contest, and such Nomination Form must be duly signed by Him / Her and His / Her signature attested by a Notary/Oath Commissioner.
- (4) The Nomination Form must be signed by a Proposer and Secunder, who shall conform to the criteria specified for such Proposer and Secunder, as prescribed under sub-paragraph (2) above.

- (5) Each Proposer's and Seconder's signature should be Duly Attested by a Notary/Oath Commissioner.
- (6) No individual shall be a Proposer or a Seconder to more than **ONE** Candidate in respect of **ONE** (1) Post; and, if an individual so does, the individual's signature on the Nomination Form delivered second in point of time to the Electoral Officer shall be deemed to be inoperative.
- (7) No person shall be permitted to withdraw their name as Proposer/Seconder, once the Nomination Form subscribed by them has been delivered to the Electoral Officer.
- (8) A Candidate shall be entitled to contest for only **ONE** (1) Post during the ICA General Election 2022.
- (9) A Candidate will be deemed to be eligible to contest for a Post only if He / She submits a Duly Completed Nomination Form and meets all the requirements specified, as determined by the Electoral Officer. Any Nomination Forms that are submitted after the deadline specified in the Election Schedule shall not be considered by the Electoral Officer and the Candidate to whom such Nomination Form relates shall not be permitted to contest the ICA General Election 2022.
- (10) The Electoral Officer reserves the right to require further Information or seek Clarification on and in respect of any matter relating to the ICA General Election 2022.
- (11) Scanned Copies of the relevant Nomination Form and the self-attested information sheet specified thereunder are required to be sent via email, marked with the subject line "**Sub: ICA General Election 2022 - Nomination Application – Name of Candidate**" to [electoralofficer@indiancricketersassociation.com](mailto:electoralofficer@indiancricketersassociation.com) on or before **5:00 PM on 11 October 2022**.
- (12) Original copies of the relevant Nomination Form and the self-attested information sheet specified thereunder are required to be sent in a sealed Envelope to the Address specified below and are required to reach such Address on or before **5:00 PM on 14 October 2022**.

- (13) All Candidates deemed to be eligible to contest for a particular Post in the ICA General Election 2022 upon examination of their Applications would be included in the Draft List of Nominated Candidates to be notified by the Electoral Officer, on the Date specified in

the Election Schedule, on the ICA's website (<https://indiancricketersassociation.com/ica-general-elections-2022/>).

- (14) Any Objections regarding the composition or constitution of the Draft List of Nominated Candidates may be sent via email marked with the subject line “**Sub: Objection – ICA List of Nominated Candidates**” to [electoralofficer@indiancricketersassociation.com](mailto:electoralofficer@indiancricketersassociation.com) as per the Dates and Timeline specified in the Election Schedule. The Electoral Officer shall Review such Objections and Dispose them in accordance with the Articles.
- (15) Any Objections raised and Withdrawal Applications Filed will be Examined and Disposed prior to the release of the final list of Contesting Candidates on the date specified in the Election Schedule.

#### **6. Know Your Candidate Information Sheets**

- (1) With a view to providing a level playing-field to all Nominated Candidates and in the interests of those on the Final Electoral Roll making informed and educated voting choices, all Nominated Candidates will be invited to submit Information Statements summarising their Agendas, Qualifications and Policies for the ICA in writing.
- (2) All such Information Statements may be sent via email marked with the subject line “**Sub: (Name of the Candidate) – Information Statement**” to [electoralofficer@indiancricketersassociation.com](mailto:electoralofficer@indiancricketersassociation.com) between 03:00 PM on 19 October 2022 to 5:00 PM on 22 October 2022. The same will be consolidated and published by the Electoral Officer on ICA's website (<https://indiancricketersassociation.com/ica-general-elections-2022/>) in accordance with the Election Schedule.

#### **7. Voting and Declaration of Results**

- (1) The Electoral Officer shall cause arrangements to be made for e-voting by Electoral Roll Members on the day(s) of the ICA General Election 2022 as specified in the Election Schedule and will call the Electoral Roll members to exercise their Voting right in respect of each of the Contested Posts.
- (2) At the closure of the Time prescribed for e-voting, the Electoral Officer shall cause the Counting of the Votes cast and announce the Results in respect of each of the Contested Posts.
- (3) After announcement of Results, the Electoral Officer shall announce the Completion of the ICA General Election 2022 process.

#### **8. Code of Conduct**

All Person Enrolled in the Electoral Roll are required to abide by the Code of Conduct prescribed hereinbelow.



- (1) In order to ensure free and fair polls, Candidates are expected to submit the Nomination Papers along with an Affidavit / Declaration covering provisions mentioned therein. Nominations received without the Affidavit / Declaration will be rejected at the time of scrutiny.
- (2) Candidates will not use unfair means including bribery, or appeal to or use of religious symbols, nor distribute gifts of various kinds such as liquor, to induce voters for support. They will strictly adhere to the prescribed campaign practices set out under Paragraph 10 below.
- (3) Proxy Voting shall not be allowed.
- (4) Campaign material if circulated should not appeal to religious, caste, or communal sentiments to entice for votes and should be not violative of the local law in force.
- (5) All candidates are expected to cooperate with the Electoral Officer and his designated staff for smooth conduct of voting during the entire process.
- (6) In case of any Dispute or Objection as to Candidacy, Disqualification, Eligibility to Vote or Admission or Rejection of Vote, the Electoral Officer shall decide the same and such decision shall be final and conclusive.

## **9. Campaign Practices**

- (1) Campaigns
  - (a) Campaigning (if any) shall be carried out by the candidates in a fair and reputable manner and, more generally, in a spirit of respect for fundamental ethical principles.
  - (b) Candidates shall conduct all campaigns with dignity and moderation and with due respect to other candidates, the ICA and the voting electorate. A candidate may produce no spoken word, written text or representation of any nature likely to harm the image of another candidate or cause him/her prejudice. Criticism of other candidates, when made, shall be confined to their policies and programmes, past record and work. Criticism based on unverified allegations or distortion shall be avoided. There shall be no appeal to caste or communal feelings for securing votes.
  - (c) Each candidate may present to the Electoral College His / Her plans and views for the Post, in the form of a written document, whatever the means used to distribute it.
  - (d) Candidates shall avoid excessive expenditure in Campaigning, recognising that it could become a factor of inequality amongst the Candidates
  - (e) No public meeting or gathering of any kind may be organised in the framework of promoting a Candidature. No use, free of charge or in return for payment, of the services of a journalist or the media may be made in order to place a candidate at an advantage or a disadvantage.

- (f) All Candidates shall avoid scrupulously all activities that are “corrupt practices”, such as bribing of voters, intimidation of voters, impersonation of voters, etc.
- (g) Candidates may in no case and under no pretext give presents, offer donations or gifts or grant advantages of whatever nature, directly or indirectly, to voting members or their representatives.

**10. Neutrality and Independence**

- (1) Candidates may not accept mandatory instructions from any public or private, natural or legal person. No direct or indirect assistance, be it financial, material or in kind, be it direct or indirect, may be given to Candidates by any third party. Candidates may not enter into any form of undertaking with any natural or legal person likely to affect the neutrality and the freedom of decision or action of their future post.
- (2) The ICA’s executive team and administration shall maintain a duty of neutrality at all times. No support or service in relation to a candidature may be requested from nor be given by any member of the ICA’s administration or staff.

**11. Disputes and Objections**

- (1) In case of any Disputes or Objection arising with respect to the ICA General Election 2022, from the declaration or publication of Electoral Roll to the Declaration of Results including but not limited to objection to candidacy, disqualification, eligibility to vote or the admission or rejection of a vote, the Electoral Officer shall decide the same and such a decision shall be final and conclusive.
